She was born February 16, 1934 in Bishopville, SC, the daughter of the late Henry and Mary Sue Hannibal. Ada married Lucius Mayfield, Sr. on September 3, 1956. She was a true faithful member of Victorious Believers Ministries C.O.G.I.C. and served faithfully as the President of the Nursing Guild. Ada wanted to further her education so she returned to school and graduated from Buena Vista High School in 1973 with her daughter, Mary. She received a Nurses Assistant certificate from Delta College. Ada was employed at Saginaw General Hospital for 28 years and performed her job faithfully. She loved gardening, painting, sewing, cooking for her family, shopping, sports cars and dressing up. Her favorite foods were yams, grapes and shrimp.
