Booker T. Mitchell age 85 of Saginaw, Michigan passed away peacefully into the arms of the Lord on September 23, 2016. He was born February 12, 1931 in Attapulcus, Georgia, the son of the late John and Susie Mitchell.

In March of 1951, Booker enlisted into the US Army where he proudly served his country during the Korean War. Following his enlistment in US Army, he moved to Saginaw, Michigan. Booker retired from General Motors Grey Iron Foundry in December 1978 after 25 years of service.

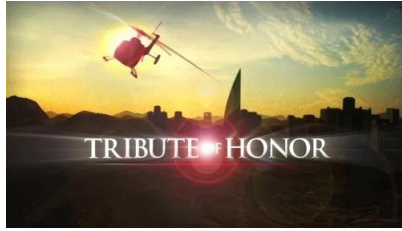
