April 25, 1947 - January 7, 2008

Friends may call at the Browne's Mortuary, 441 North Jefferson Avenue, on Sunday from 2:00 until 8:00 p.m. Mr. Bruce Richard Poindexter, Sr. passed away Monday, January 7, 2008 at the age of 60 years. He was born April 25, 1947, the son of Lillie Mae Williams, his biological mother, and Richard and Mertie Poindexter, his adoptive parents. Bruce was the first African-American to graduate from Bridgeport High School in 1965. He was retired from the G. M. Grey Iron Foundry and was a member of UAW Local 668.
