Harvey, husband, father, brother, uncle, cousin, grandfather, great-grandfather and friend, went home to be with the Lord. Carl was born in 1932 in Eupora, Mississippi to the late Charlie O. and Ariana (Latham) Harvey. He attended Webster County Schools in Eupora, Mississippi. He came to Saginaw, Michigan in September 1952. Upon arriving here in Saginaw, he obtained a job with the G.M. Chevrolet Grey Iron foundry. He retired in 1983, after serving 34 years and was a member of UAW Local 668. His hobbies included fishing, gardening and playing softball.
