Jefferson Ave., on Thursday from 2:00 until 8:00 p.m. Beloved father, grandfather, brother and friend, Dr. Charles Lewis Turpin was born November 19th, 1923 in Crawfordsville, Indiana to Reverend Robert R. and Annie E. Turpin. He spent most of his childhood in LeRoy, New York, until his family moved to Flint, Michigan in 1939, where his father was Pastor of Mt. Olive Baptist Church. He graduated from Flint Central High School in 1941, and went on to college at the former Hampton Institute, Hampton, Virginia. After graduation, he entered dental school at Meharry Medical College in Nashville, Tennessee. There he earned his D.D.S. degree in 1947. In 1948, Dr. Turpin began his dental practice in Saginaw, Michigan, retiring in 1983. He left his Saginaw practice for two years when he was drafted as a dentist in the U.S. Army, and spent two years stationed in England beginning in 1956. Dr. Turpin married Helen Joan Banks June 15, 1949 in Columbus, Ohio. She predeceased him in 1970. He then married Phyllis "Toni" Krause in 1976. She predeceased him in 1996. Dr. Turpin was a member of the Saginaw Housing Commission for many years in the 1960s. He was an avid golfer, and a member of the first flight of the Detroit Duffers Golf Club. He played in many tournaments and collected quite a few trophies. One of Dr. Turpin's little known talents was a

beautiful bass singing voice. During college, he traveled the country with the popular Hampton Quartet, the Meharry Singers, and other groups. He also sang in the choir at St. Paul's Episcopal Church. He leaves to cherish his memory, one daughter, Ann Turpin Williams of Saginaw; two grandchildren, Elise Williams and Nickolas Williams; one brother, Dr. Robert (Elizabeth) Turpin, Lansing, Michigan; three nieces, one nephew; many other relatives and friends. He was predeceased by a stepson, Gary L. Krause.
