After starting a family, they relocated to Saginaw, MI, where he worked at the Malleable Iron foundry for 41 years. That's what he loved doing, along with fishing and sitting on his porch with an open door policy. After 51 years of marriage, he also inherited a family where he was not just an in-law.
