April 18, 1928 - September 19, 2008

On September 19, 2008, Mr. Edward Herring went home to be with Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Mr. Herring was born on April 18, 1928, a twin son to the late Marshall and Fannie Leggett Herring, in Hazelhurst, Mississippi. He was united in marriage to Miss JoAnne Moore on April 22, 1952, in Hazlehurst, Mississippi, at her parents' home. He worked at the Malleable Iron, Central Foundry of Saginaw and was a member of Local 455. He faithfully served his country in the US Army during the Korean Conflict. He was honorably discharged on October 11, 1952. He became a member of Victorious Believers Ministries, Church of God in Christ, in 2000 under the pastoral leadership of Bishop Marvin C. Pryor. He was a faithful member and greeter at Victorious Believers until his illness. Besides his loving wife of 56 years, Mr. Herring leaves to cherish his memories three daughters: Gail B.
