Barnes Jr. passed away Saturday, September 6, 2008 at home after a lengthy illness. He was born March 18, 1920 in Nashville, Tennessee. He was a longtime resident of Saginaw, Michigan and relocated to Milwaukee, Wisconsin in 2002. Elder Barnes was married to Mother Willie Mae (Sewell) Barnes for 41 years. She preceded him in death in 1987. Together they raised their eleven children in the fear of the Lord. A diligent hard working husband, father and retiree of Chevrolet Grey Iron Foundry, Elder Barnes dedicated his life to serving God and his fellowman. His faithful service began as a Deacon, Ordained Minister, Church Administrator, Dean of the Sunday School Department of Southwest Michigan Jurisdiction #2 and 50 years as a Sunday School Superintendent at Victorious Believers Ministry in Saginaw, Michigan.
