Mr. Elmore Hall passed away on Sunday, December 13, 2015 at the age of 83 years. He was born November 7, 1932 in Saginaw, MI, the son of the late Tollie B. (Barnes) and Edward Hall, Sr. Following graduation from Saginaw High School, he enlisted in the U.S. Army where he served for 2 years.

Elmore married Margaret F. Smith on June 23, 1962. He retired from the U.S. Postal Service after more than 27 years of service. Elmore enjoyed watching westerns on television, working crossword puzzles and helping people in any way that he could.

He leaves to cherish his memory, his wife, Margaret F. Hall; two sons, David J. and Duane J. Hall, both of Saginaw, three brothers, Willie J. Hall of Redford, MI, James (Carol) Hall of Ann Arbor, MI and Bill (Alice) Chesney of Sicklerville, NJ; one sister, Lorraine Conley of Saginaw, MI; and many nieces, nephews, cousins, other relatives and friends.

He was preceded in death by five brothers, Barnes Lee, Tellis, Wendall, Eddie B. and Edward Hall; and one sister, Nettie Bell McKenzie.
