



Mr. Eluehue Crudup

January 31, 1953 - December 30, 2020

Eluehue Crudup was born on January 31, 1953 in North Little Rock, Arkansas to Arvie Lee Crudup and Suzanne Robinson. He passed away on Wednesday, December 2020 at the age of 67 years.

He grew to manhood in North Little Rock and in Toledo, Ohio before moving to reside in Saginaw, Michigan. In Saginaw, Eluehue worked as an assembly lineman and line coordinator at Saginaw Steering Gear, Div. General Motors Corp./Delphi Steering Systems for over 25 years. Eluehue earned and maintained licensure as a building and remodeling contractor in the early 1990's, founding McAlmont Construction soon after.

Eluehue established and strengthened his relationship with Jesus Christ at Bethlehem Temple Church of The Apostolic Faith following his arrival in Saginaw. There, Eluehue grew in knowledge and understanding of scripture, eventually becoming a bible study leader and teacher for many years. Eluehue married Ivy J. Crudup nee Reed, their union yielded two sons Eluehue Crudup II and Delvon D. Crudup.

Eluehue's strength and spirit live on in his surviving sons. He leaves behind three sisters, Diane Whitehead, Elaine Moore and Phyllis Crudup. His passing is preceded by that of a fourth sister, Doris Annette Weston; he also leaves behind several brothers, Arvie Lee Crudup, Jr., Tommy Don Crudup, Ricky

Peterson and Anthony “Tiger” Williams, all of North Little Rock, AR, Wayne Alvine Crudup of Okemos, MI and Bruce “Poncho” Crudup of Saginaw; Eluehue is further survived by numerous beloved nieces, nephews, cousins-in-law and godchildren.

Mr. Crudup will be remembered in honor, and with love by hundreds of friends and acquaintances gathered across his life’s journey.

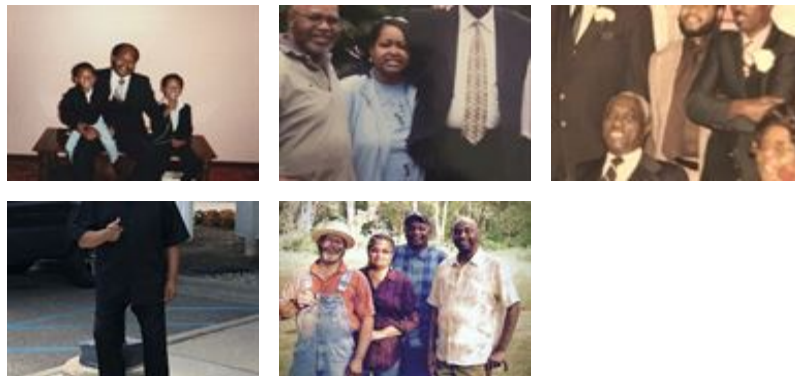

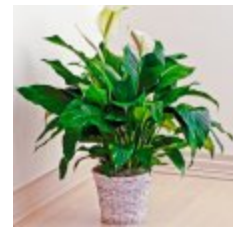

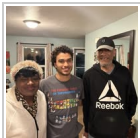
