Ms. Elzora Hicks passed away at home on Saturday, March 5, 2011 at the age of 91 years. She was born February 17, 1920 in Council Bluff, IA to Augusta and Lonzio Williams. Elzora was a very loving woman whose joy was her family. She loved to read, travel, do crossword puzzles and watch the Sy Fy channel. Some activities became harder to enjoy in later years but were still her passion. Elzora married Carl DeGroat in high school. That marriage produced two sons, Carleton Edward DeGroat and Celester Raymond DeGroat. Some 15 years later, she married Herbert Hicks of Arkansas, and that marriage produced Augusta Marie Hicks Woods and Elaine Renee Hicks. During her life, she had been a long time member of Christ Community Church. She owned and operated her own beauty shop. After years of ownership, she went on to work in sales for two major department stores, Arlans and Montgomery Ward. She continued to pursue her education, graduating from Saginaw Business College. She then worked as secretary for the Saginaw County Community Action Committee, then clerk typist for the Saginaw Police Department. She was promoted to secretary to the Saginaw Police Chief, from which she retired some 30 years ago.
