Essie Mae Curry was born July 6, 1912 to the late John and Mary Ford in Webb, Alabama. Essie made her transition from Earth to Glory on October 4, 2014 at the tender age of 102, after a lengthy illness surrounded by family.

She married Perry T. Curry on April 4, 1936. They were married for 49 years until he preceded her in death. After leading Perry to Christ, Essie and Perry worked tirelessly to lead the lost to Christ. She was a faithful member of the South 17th Street Church of Christ where she remained steadfast until her health prevented her from doing so. In illness, she never stopped serving the Lord and remained a hard-fighting soldier on the battlefield for the Lord. Essie completed the eighth grade and managed to teach of Jesus as a scholar. She was an advocate for education and pushed her children to complete high school and college if possible. She was a resident of Carrollton Township in Saginaw, MI.
