



Mr. Floyd T. Wilson, Sr.

April 1, 1931 - June 20, 2023

Floyd T. Wilson, Sr., age 92, a former resident of Saginaw, Michigan, was born in Plain Dealing, LA on April 1, 1931 to the late Wesley and Mittie Lue Wilson. He passed away peacefully on June 20th, 2023, at Mt. Olivet Careview Home, in Minneapolis, MN where he had been receiving medical care since 2017.

On January 17, 1952, during the Korean War, Floyd enlisted in the U.S. Army and served in active duty. He was honorably discharged in October 1953. Recognized as a decorated veteran, Floyd was awarded the Korean War Service Medal, the National Defense Service Medal and the United Nations Service Medal.

In 1965, Floyd returned to Saginaw, Michigan and married Paula McFallen Fletcher where they raised their blended family. He supported his family working as plant security for General Motors culminating with a well-deserved retirement after a 33 year career.

In his spare time Floyd enjoyed rehabbing homes with his wife and adding them to their rental property portfolio. They also enjoyed traveling with their motor home club, visiting campgrounds and fellowshiping on weekends and holidays. Other hobbies that he enjoyed included, fishing, hunting and in general tinkering in the barn on the 18 acres family home. Later Floyd and Paula moved to Panama City, Panama to enjoy retirement until Floyd moved to Minneapolis, MN for medical care.
