Freddye later moved to Saginaw, MI and began work at St. Luke's Hospital and Covenant Hospital. Every Monday, Freddye volunteered at the blood bank assisting in drawing and taking blood pressure. Freddye enjoyed traveling and often traveled to Toronto, Canada, Orlando, FL, Gatlinburg, TN and back home to Benham, KY. Freddye found her true love in Saginaw in 1968 and married Carl Howard, Sr. he preceded her in death in 1987. To this union was born, one son, Carl Howard, Jr.

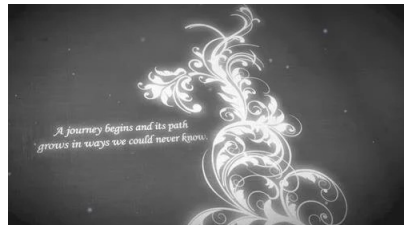

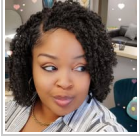
