She was born July 3, 1941 in Selma Alabama, the youngest of five children, to Georgia and William Walker, Sr. She was united in holy matrimony with Eugene Guster on June 19, 1959. Their union produced one son, Eugene L. Guster, Jr. (deceased); and two daughters, Debra Guster and Victoria Guster-Hines. Georgia received an Undergraduate Degree from Michigan State University, and a Masters Degree from Central Michigan University. She retired from Saginaw Public Schools after 35 years of dedicated service as teacher and counselor, where she inspired her students to reach for their dreams. In 1983 Georgia became a member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., Eta Upsilon Omega Chapter. She attained Silver Star status in 2008 after completing 25 years of service. Her memory will be cherished by her husband, daughters, brother, William (Dora) Walker; sister-in-law, Laura (Cleophus) Guster-Crawford; four grandchildren, Eugena Guster, Douglas Hines, Jr., Crystal Guster, and Victoria Brown.
