Mr. Gregory Lawrence Harvin was born on August 12, 1957 in Flint, Michigan the son of Bennie and Geneva Harvin. He passed away on January 28, 2024 at the age of 66 years.

He accepted Christ as his personal Savior as a young adult under the guidance of the late Rev. Seldon Williams, Jr. He served faithfully in his church whenever he was not on the road.

Gregory attended Beecher High School "Class of 1976" where he was a member of the Wrestling Team, earned the distinct honor of being given A Good Citizenship Award by the Michigan State Police in 1973. During his time at Beecher High School, he joined the Boy Scouts of America and became an Assistant Scoutmaster and the Arrowhead District First Aid-O-Rec. On January 14, 1974 he became the first Black youth to become an Eagle Scout in the Chippewa District with Boy Scout Troop 191 and later became a member of the Order of the Arrow. This was certified by the National Boy Scouts of America.

Gregory earned his Bachelor of Science Degree from Northern Michigan University majoring in Conservation. After graduating, he started C.I.H. Trucking Enterprises/Owner Operator which solidified his career as a professional truck driver. He retained a multi-year contract with Atlas Van Lines, Special Products Division. This led him to make many connections on the road with other truck drivers. Gregory never met a stranger and loved to talk. Whenever he met new drivers that were just starting, he gave them good advice from his experiences on the road. When he wasn't "easing down the road" and exploring the country, Greg loved to barbeque (skills which he took after his dad). He also loved to watch the History Channel, Western movies, Sci-fi movies and his favorite "It's a Wonderful Life", "Man" as we called him absolutely loved to spend time with family and friends.
