



## Houston Myles

March 5, 1931 - June 17, 2014

Mr. Houston Myles passed away Tuesday, June 17, 2014 at the age of 83 years. He was born March 5, 1931 in Bay Springs, MS to Bertha (Mason) and Elizah Myles.

Houston was a veteran of the United States Army and served during the Korean Conflict. He was a member of Galilee Baptist Church for over 25 years, until his health failed. Houston was a self-taught guitarist and played many years for his church choir. He also was a health nut. He ran five miles a day and would roller-skate three days a week.

He leaves behind to cherish his memory, one daughter, Dianne J. (Fred Jr.) Welch; sister, Dorothy (Joseph) Smith; brother, James Myles of California; niece, Sebrena Ann Smith; favorite niece, Delores (Johnson) Davis; eight grandchildren; nineteen great-grandchildren; brother-in-law, John (Verna) Ellis; and a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

His wife, Mary Lou Myles, and his brother, Elijah Myles, preceded him in death.
