



Mr. Jerry Moore

May 12, 1950 - June 4, 2026

Jerry “Buzz” Moore was born on May 12, 1950, in Saginaw, MI., to the late Joe W. Moore and Marjell “Thompson” Moore. He passed away at the age of 76 years.

He was baptized by Pastor Roosevelt Austin and became a member of Zion Baptist Church in 1962. Jerry graduated from Saginaw High School in 1968. He attended Delta Community College, completing studies in Landscape Design. Jerry joined the Marines in 1970 and received a National Defense Service Medal. Jerry then returned to Delta College, completing business courses, from 1972 - 1973.

Jerry then began and became very proficient in his career in landscape and design. Jerry installed hundreds of irrigation systems for businesses, his mother’s home at 2946 Arlington, including Pastor Creflo Dollar. He was a subcontractor on Atlanta, Hartsville Airport; built a waterfall at the entrance to Guilford Forests, Atlanta, irrigation/landscaping, like the private garden, he designed for Atlanta Crowe’s Nest Megaplex owner, “LC” Crowe.

Jerry engaged all the children in the family. Jerry possessed a singular ability to delve into their world, and make the time they spent with him unforgettable. Jerry never married, but lived in Atlanta for 15 years with the love of his life, Sylvia, while helping raise her three children.

In 2012, Jerry returned from Atlanta to Saginaw, to take care of his aging mother, Marjell. He was joined by his brother Larry Moore, who retired in 2014, and the two of them lived in Saginaw, caring for their mother Marjell, until she passed in August 2023.

Jerry's hobbies included playing chess at which he became masterful; making bracelets and necklaces, and collecting African artifacts. Jerry was a math whiz, completing complex calculations, for his projects directly in his head. He was a very accomplished poker player. Jerry loved music, especially jazz, rap, and R&B in that order.

Jerry "Buzz" Moore made his final transition on June 4th, 2026. Jerry was preceded in death by his father, Joe W. Moore in 1987. His mother Marjell "Margie" Moore transitioned in August 2023 at the age of 95.
