Jesse Guerrero was born in October 11, 1923 in Valentine, Texas to Gregorio and Delores (Ramos) Guerrero. He passed away on January 25, 2020 at the age of 96 years.

The family moved to Austin, Texas in 1929. He worked at a grocery store as a teen. Jesse left Texas in 1948 moving to Saginaw, Michigan. He worked at Malleable Iron Plant for General Motors briefly and then was drafted into the U.S. Army from 1949-1950.
