Reverend Joe N. Glenn, a man that loved God, has transitioned from this life of labor to the place that God has prepared for him. Joe went home to be with the Lord at Covenant Hospital on Tuesday, January 29, 2013 in the year of our Lord.

Rev. Joe was born on January 10, 1921 in Ruleville, MS. He was the only son born to the late Tommie and Minnie Glenn. Greater Freewill MBC was his church home and spiritual family. Joe married the love of his life, Rosie Lee (Moten) Glenn, who preceded him in death in 2002. He served 4 years in the United States Army and received an honorable discharge. He retired from General Motors in 1976 with over 30 years of service.

Joe and Rosie shared over 50 years of marriage, truly brought together by the Lord.
