November 14, 1948 - April 13, 2020

Deacon John William Wright was called home by his heavenly father on Monday, April 13, 2020. He was the youngest of six children born to Willie and Theodosia (Bennett) Wright, on November 14, 1948, in Saginaw, Michigan, where he lived for 71 years.

After graduating from Saginaw High School, class of 1966, John joined the United States Air Force, and served for four years during the Vietnam War, working in Aircraft Maintenance. Upon returning home to Saginaw, John enrolled in Delta college, where he earned an Associate of Science degree in 1972. Afterward, John began a career as a Radiologic Technologist, and a Cardiac Catheterization Tech at Covenant HealthCare Hospital (formerly St. Luke's Hospital). John's career and life's work at Covenant HealthCare lasted for 42 years before he retired in 2015. He was beloved by his coworkers. His warm smile, infectious laugh, and strong work ethic brought joy to everyone who knew him.

John professed faith in Christ and was baptized at an early age. He loved his church family and was a devoted member of "Greater Williams Temple, Church of God in Christ". He was appointed Deacon under the leadership of

his late pastor Bishop H. J. Williams. Under the leadership of his current pastor, Superintendent Arthur L. Aikin, he served as Vice-President of the Trustee Board, Co-Chair of the Deacon Board and Assistant Sunday School Superintendent. He was always a willing volunteer to support his pastor and church. He was loved by his church family who were very diligent in praying for him; he is greatly missed.

John was united in marriage to Lucinda Scott, and from that union they had two children: daughter, Cortney Lynn Wright, and son, John William Wright II.

John loved sports, and was an avid fan of basketball, baseball, football, and bowling, recording a 300 game on more than one occasion as a member of a bowling league. He loved going on trips to visit family and friends, and took great pride in attending family reunions. John's passion for life will be remembered and celebrated by all who knew and loved him.

John was preceded in death by his parents Willie L. and Theodosia Wright; sisters, Ora L. Johnson and Mary A. Scott; and brother, Martin E. Wright. In addition to his children, Cortney L. Wright, and John W. Wright II, he is survived by his sister, Annie P. Wright of Saginaw, Michigan; brother, Lester E. Wright of Converse, Texas; god-brothers, Joseph Bady and Terry Triplett; former spouse, Lucinda Scott Jones; along with a host of nieces, nephews, other loving relatives and friends.
