The road was rough but now the heavenly cobblestones have fused together and allowed her to walk the path that leads to our salvation. Leatha Theresa French was born to Anna (Miller) and Thomas French in Kansas City, Kansas, on July 4, 1928, the youngest of ten siblings.

Being raised as Catholic, she attended the Church Of Our Lady Catholic School from elementary to high school and after graduation she attended Kansas Vocational School in Topeka, Kansas where she met a young basketball player who was well on his way to the pros by the name of Herbert Herd. Leatha was mesmerized by this young man and after dating for awhile they married, migrated to Michigan, and began a family which consisted of eight children, Stephanie Elaine Smith-Wilson -(Fred), Herbert Junior (Vanessa) Herd, Keith Bolivar (Connie) Herd, Ronald Cortez (Priscilla) Herd, Theresa Maria (Tommie) Gipson, Joseph Bernard (Verlona) Herd, Catherine Michelle, (deceased) and Kathleen Regina (Richard) Brown.

During her life, Leatha was very active in the community. She was a civil rights

activist during a time when there was much conflict going on within the United States and racism was very prevalent in Saginaw, Michigan. She met numerous activists whom she helped organize various groups to impact the movement on a national level. She engaged in several hobbies which consisted of sewing with her fellow members of the Crawlers Sewing Club, singing with her singing group, visiting the elderly, and other hobbies too numerous to mention. Leatha was employed at Sacred Heart Catholic School, Eaton Manufacturing and also worked as a preschool teacher for Saginaw County Child Development Centers, Inc. until she retired in 1998. Leatha was a very compassionate woman who loved to help others. She volunteered for the March of Dimes Organization and helped to change the lives of many people in the Saginaw County area. She was also instrumental in helping to develop the Head Start program in Saginaw, Michigan.

After the sudden passing of Herbert Herd, Leatha remarried to Neville Britto on November 22, 1974, whom she enjoyed traveling the world with, visiting numerous places such as Italy, France, Copenhagen, Canada, and India.

On August 3, 2016, Leatha transitioned to her heavenly home after suffering a lengthy illness. During her last days, she enjoyed visiting with her only living sibling James (Olivia) French with whom she shared many wonderful memories.

She leaves to cherish her memory her loving husband Neville, two sisters-in-law Emeline Lemos (Jabalpur, India) and June Britto (Bangalore, India); one brother-in-law, Rodney Britto (Copenhagen, Denmark); a special niece who was more like a sister than a niece Trina (Sylvester Wallace); seven children; 23 grandchildren; 35 great-grandchildren; 13 great-great-grandchildren; numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends, her faithful nail technician Teri Moten, and Caregiver Rachel Anaya.

It is very evident that by no accident Leatha was placed here to fill a void in

the lives of all who knew her. We're beginning to see that she had a very special purpose. Out of all of the billions of applicants, the Heavenly Father chose Leatha to take on the task of raising seven children and assisting in the raising of a niece to become the successful people they are today.

Leatha was preceded in death by her parents Anna and Thomas French; five sisters Elray, Nan, Goldie, Tillie, and Cecil; three brothers Tom, Hezekiah, and Wilford; her first husband, Herbert Herd; one daughter Catherine,; one brother-in-law, Rev. Kenneth Britto (Bangalore, India).

The family of Leatha Britto would like to thank the staff of St. Mary's Hospital who assisted in making her last days comfortable enough to give her the strength to go home.

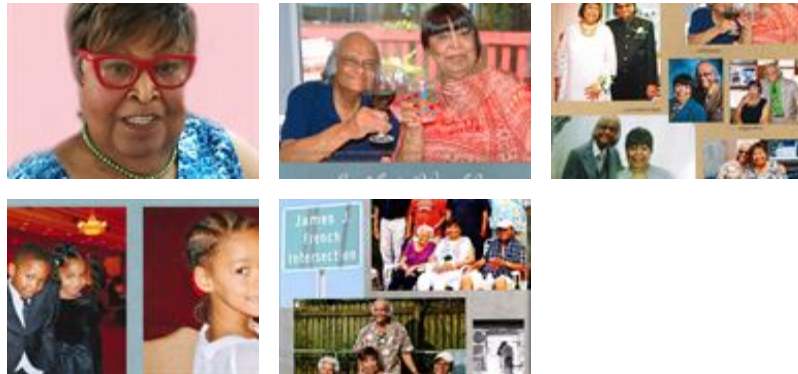
