Sister Lois Ann Sheaffer sfcc, daughter of Philip and Mary Catherine Sheaffer went to her heavenly home Monday, July 13, 2015 at the age of 77 years.

She ministered on the Eastside of Saginaw for over forty years. Sister Lois served as a Dominican Sister for Christian Community in several parishes, schools, Good Neighbors Mission and Saginaw Habitat for Humanity. In later years her special ministry addressed the needs of youth in the community, the neighborhood and a safe environment for the city. For her it was important to help people with their basic needs and beautify the community with flowers. For over twenty years she has served in the Houghton-Jones Neighborhood. She was an active member of St. Joseph Church and the NAACP.

Sister Lois Sheaffer is survived by five brothers and two sisters, Larry Sheaffer (Josie), Nancy Sheaffer-Duff (Robert), Thomas Sheaffer (Phyllis), Daniel Sheaffer (Brenda), Roland Sheaffer (Lorna), Philip Sheaffer (Janet), Diane Weldon (Robert), and many very special nieces and nephews. Besides her family she leaves many faithful friends, especially the neighbors of Houghton Jones Neighborhood and beyond, Sisters for Christian Community, and Dominican Sisters.

Sis. Lois was preceded in death by her parents; sister-in-law, Patricia and nephew, Jonathan Weldon.

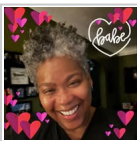

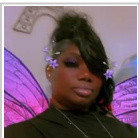
