She was born in Seale (Russell County), Alabama to the union of the late Jackson and Lillie Beatrice Scott Cook. She attended and graduated from Spencer High School in Columbus GA in 1955 with her high-school sweetheart. Their courtship began when they were 15 year olds. They would marry shortly after graduation and spend 53 years together. Upon moving to Saginaw, MI, Mary began her career with Saginaw General Hospital as a Practical Nurse, then joining the practice of Dr. Webb, followed by Dr. Heavenrich, and later becoming Officer Manager of Bell Engineering of which she retired in 2001. One of her loves was traveling. She went on to work with Opperman Travel Agency as a consultant and later co-owned Air Plus Travel Agency. During her retirement years, she also worked as a greeter at Browne's Mortuary. Mary loved the fellowship of her family, whether it was traveling on family vacation, playing scrabble, Phase 10, Uno Attack or playing the Wii. She would not be left out no matter what the event. She loved to organize bus trips for shopping, plays, and casino trips. Mary is known for always telling jokes, especially on her bus trips. She had the timing of a professional comic. She will be remembered to

most as mother, sister, grandmother and GG, but to her high school sweetheart, she will forever be remembered as his "Cookie". She had a special gift of making anyone feel they were the only one special at that moment. Mary was active in her church and loved her Sunday school class. Some of her involvement in the church has included: Preschool Sunday School Teacher, Sewing Club, Trustee Board, Youth Fellowship Group, Beautification Ministry, Deaconess and a Charter Member of the Courtesy Board. She had a great concern for her community and contributed to its improvement through volunteering in various organizations. She was a long-term board member and former President of the local chapter of Habitat for Humanity. She was also a charter member and former President of the Tri-City Chapter, The Links, Incorporated. In addition to this, she served as Chairperson for the Ebony Fashion Fair show for over ten years.
