Our beloved Mary Alice (McBride) Hammond was born May 14, 1937, in Grenada, MS, to the union of Mr. Nathaniel McBride and Ms. Stella Mae (Wright) Douglas.

Mrs. Hammond was very close to her cousin Minnie Pearl (Barnes) Armstrong and because she was the only child at that time, they treated each other much like sisters. She spent her childhood in Mississippi and was blessed with an angelic voice. She was a member of her high school choir and sang in a quartet at the Union Theater.

Mary Alice was also a stunning beauty. She met and married Fred Hammond and had three children, Fredrick Jerome Hammond, Valorie (Hammond) Green, and Jeffrey Carl Hammond. They divorced in 1958. Mary then was blessed with two more children, Deniece McBride and Andre Giles McBride by Stonewall Ingram. It was then that she decided that she wanted to pursue a better life for her and her children.

Mary summoned her faith and courage and joined her father in Saginaw, MI. She took her youngest children with her and eventually she was able to reunite with her oldest three children.

Mary made a brief move to Chicago, IL in 1968. However, due to the persistence and tears of her eldest daughter Valorie, she moved back to Saginaw three months later. She found employment as a cook at Maccabee Gardens (now know as Magnum Care of Saginaw) and The Hideout Bar. She then became a dedicated homemaker and spent her time caring for and raising her children.

In 1975, she met the love of her life, Alphonso Weathers, affectionately known as "Red". Red was walking down Perkins St. when he spotted her and could not resist turning around. They were inseparable for almost 30 years. He cooked meals for her and she made him quilts. He was a father to her children and a grandfather to her grand-children. They had an unconditional love like no other. Together, they dedicated their lives to Christ

in the early 2000's and joined Corinthian Baptist Church. Sadly, she lost her beloved Red in 2003 and the fire in her eyes began to dim. Mary continued her walk at New Hope Missionary Baptist Church where she remained a member until her passing.

On Saturday, June 11, 2016, after a long battle with respiratory illness, Mary Alice Hammond made her transition to be with the Lord.

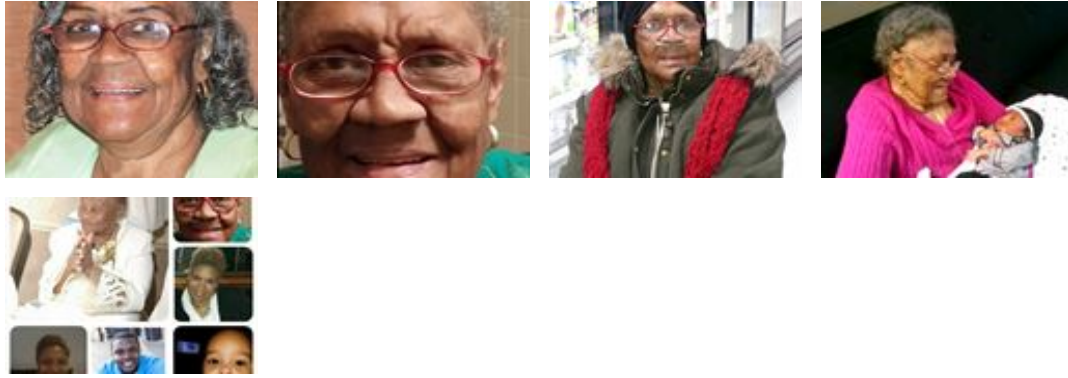
