



## Mother Icie Belle Weathers

November 11, 1915 - December 20, 2012

Our beloved Mother Icie Belle Weathers left our earth realm on December 20, 2012 at the age of 97 years young. Affectionately known as “Mother Weathers”, she was born on November 11, 1915 in Ethelville, MS.

Mother Weathers was a member of St. Paul Baptist Church, where she served with great passion for many years as a Sunday School teacher, in the choir and on the Mother’s Board.
