Mrs. Nancy Prince Beverly passed away from this life and entered into eternal rest with her Heavenly Father on Tuesday, April 15, 2008, at Heartland Healthcare-Saginaw at the age of 90 years. Nancy was born on September 10, 1917, to Rev. Peter and Queenie Prince in Morengo County, Alabama. She was united in marriage to Allen Beverly in Toledo, Ohio in 1938 and returned to Saginaw where she resided to this day. From this union five children were born. Nancy accepted Christ as her personal savior at an early age and joined Rose Hill Missionary Baptist Church in 1976 where she actively served on the Kitchen Committee for 11-1/2 years, sang in the Inspirational Choir for four years, was secretary to the Pastor's Aide Committee for three years while serving as an usher simultaneously since 1976.
