She moved to Saginaw, Michigan in 1936 at the age of 15 years old. She was a graduate of Saginaw High School c/o 1939. She married the love of her life, Johnny M. Bryant, on February 24, 1940. He preceded her in death on May 9, 2003. She had been a faithful member of Bethel A.M.E. Church since 1936. She was a past member of Stewardess Bd. #1., The Busy Bee Club, “Queen” of the Retirees Club and the Travel Club. Ophelia worked at GM Grey Iron Foundry Local 668 (Metal Casting) in the core room for over 25 years. She was one of the women pioneers that opened doors for other women to work in the plant. She was a past member of F.W.C.C. Old Timers Club. She loved to cook, bowl, crochet, knit, garden, travel, watch the Detroit Tigers, bingo and had a flair for fashion until her illness of Alzheimers.
