Mr. Quinton Kimble born July 29, 1919 in Waco, Texas. Quinton Kimble died Monday, November 22, 2021 at Covenant Medical Center in Saginaw, Michigan.

In his 102 years on this earth, he has been a Retailer, a Musician, an Entrepreneur and a Minister. He was a soldier in World War II and graduated from Paul Quinn College. He once received the Small Business Man of the Year Award in Detroit, Michigan; he also had an article written up about him in the Saginaw Newspaper.

Quinton Kimble was well known in the community, and two years ago had his “100th Birthday Celebration” at McDonalds. He could often be seen around town playing his trumpet. His favorite pastimes were hanging out at McDonald’s or visiting the local Thrift stores. Quinton was a very colorful and unforgettable character and he wore a suit and tie every day. 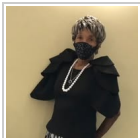
