Conner was born November 10, 1955 in Greenville, MS to the late Robert Conner, Sr. and Irene Conner. His father preceded him in death. Rev. Conner graduated from Saginaw High School in 1973 and received his Bachelor of Business Administration from Northwood Institute in 1977. He was baptized by Pastor Roosevelt Mosley at Saint Paul Baptist Church. He was called to the ministry in 1986 and received his Certificate of License under Pastor Mosley on August 10, 1986. He was ordained on July 28, 1991 under the authority of New Hope Baptist Church. He was currently serving as assistant pastor at Bethlehem Baptist Church. He was employed at Delphi Steering Gear for 29 1/2 years, up until his homegoing. Rev.
