May 1, 1927 - August 15, 2009

Family hour will take place at 9:45 a.m. Friday, August 21, 2009 at the Victorious Believers Ministries Church of God in Christ, 624 South Outer Drive, with the funeral commencing at 11:00 a.m. Bishop Marvin C. Pryor, Pastor. Rev. Earl O. Crump, of Door of Faith Christian Church in Pontiac, MI, will officiate with interment in Forest Lawn Cemetery. Friends may call at The New Christ Community Church, 3302 Grant Street, on Thursday from 2:00 until 7:00 p.m., where the family will be present from 2:00 until 6:00 p.m. "Then Peter said, silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee; In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk" (Acts 3:6) William Demone Aldridge was born on May 1, 1927 the second oldest of five children to the blessed union of the late Bill and Annie Lee Aldridge, in Eupora, Mississippi. Being the only son, he was often accused of jealously protecting his four sisters. He demonstrated considerable athletic talent as a youngster. He was a four-sport star in high school playing football, basketball, baseball and track. Many residents of the Saginaw community best knew Rev. Aldridge as a very unyielding, animated sports referee, officiating city-league basketball games. William Aldridge completed his high school diploma at Rusk College. He then completed three years of college academic work at Rusk before deciding to respond to God's call to service in 1948. The initial call to the ministry came at the tender age of seventeen, in June of 1944. The early years in the ministry proved to be a period of sacrifice and significant challenge. Between 1948 and 1953, Rev. Aldridge pastored at five different

rural Mississippi churches. Rev. Bothuel, Pastor of Bethlehem Baptist Church, introduced Rev. Aldridge to Christ Community Church on Palm Sunday in 1954. On the following Easter Sunday he accepted the pastorate at Christ Community, where he pastored until retiring in 2004. He taught in the Buena Vista School District and retired from the General Motors Malleable Iron Plant after 28 years in July of 1981. Rev. Aldridge met Eugene Erby, the sophisticated and stylish daughter of Shepherd and Mary Erby while attending Rusk College. They were married in 1948 and to this union were born eight children, including triplets. He leaves to cherish his memory, children: Mayor Joyce (Dr. Eugene) Seals, Prophetess Mary McDonald-Barnes, Pastors Leona (James) Glenn, Demona (Glenn) Reed, Rev.
