



Rev. Patten

August 31, 1919 - June 18, 2007

Family hour will take place at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, June 25, 2007 at Rose Hill Missionary Baptist Church, 2403 E. Remington, with the funeral service commencing at 11:00 a.m. Pastor Murry Culberson will officiate with interment in Forest Lawn Cemetery. Friends may call at the church on Sunday from 2:00 until 6:00 p.m. Our beloved father, grandfather, great-grandfather, great-great-grandfather and spiritual leader went home to be with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on June 18, 2007. Our beloved father was born on August 31, 1919 in Aiken, SC to the union of Anna and Henry Patten. Rev. Patten served in the Armed Forces of the United States where he was honorably discharged on March 26, 1946. He accepted Christ at an early age in Aiken, SC. Rev. Patten married Flora Oakman in 1942. She preceded him in death in 1991. From that union, two daughters were born, Alma and Mozella. Rev. Patten served as a faithful deacon and director of the Male Chorus of Zion Baptist Church. He later moved to Corinthian Baptist Church where he became the Assistant Pastor. In 1956, Rev. Patten joined Truevine Baptist Church where he became the Assistant Pastor and organized the Male Chorus. Rev. Patten attended the Owosso Bible College and was ordained in 1959. In December of 1972, Rev. Patten was called to pastor the Rosehill Baptist Church, where he served faithfully for 30 years. Rev. Patten was a faithful servant of God, a great teacher who enjoyed traveling, loved to pastor, sing and had love and admiration for his family. Rev. Patten was a charter member of the Saginaw Valley Baptist District Association where he served as a teacher for 25 years.

He served as president and song worship leader of the Saginaw Valley Baptist District Congress of Christian Education. In 1994, he married Evelyn Mosley, who preceded him in death in 2004. From that union, he gained six step-children. He leaves to cherish his memory, two daughters, Alma Johnson and Mozella Reed; step-children, Joyce Brown, Carol Purches, Leslie (Bruce) Caradine, Rev. Roosevelt (Yashica) Mosley, Jr., Carl Mosley and Bruce Mosley; 10 grandchildren and many great-grandchildren, great-great-grandchildren; a host of pastors, associates, friends and the Rose Hill Baptist Church family; special friends, Rev. and Mrs. E.W. Bothuel and Rev. Roosevelt Liddell; and special love, his little dog, Pee Wee. Rev. Patten was also preceded in death by his parents, three sisters, two brothers, and one grandson.
