



Rev. Sidney L. Jones

May 29, 1939 - December 17, 2013

Reverend Sidney Lanier Jones (A.K.A. “Boy” by his family) was released from the bonds of his earthly body and entered the kingdom of heaven on Tuesday, December 17th, 2013.

Rev. Jones was born May 29th, 1939 in Simmesport, Louisiana to the late Mr. and Mrs. James and Amy Jones. As a young man he joined the armed forces and served two years before being honorably discharged. He then relocated to Saginaw, MI where he worked for General Motors until he retired due to disability.

Confessing Christ at an early age, Rev. Jones was a man of God and received his Certificate of Ordination on April 13th, 1975 through The New Morning Star Baptist Church. He later went on to serve as an Associate Pastor of Morning Star Missionary Baptist Church. At the time of his passing, he belonged to the Mt. Carmel Baptist Church in Saginaw, MI.

The memory of Rev. Jones will remain in the hearts and minds of his two children: daughter, Anisa L. Jordan (Emanuel) of Chicago, IL and son, Lanier Jones, of Birmingham, Alabama; one granddaughter, Kiera Jones; three sisters, Earline Jones of Simmesport, LA, Rosa Lee Winchester of Saginaw, MI, and Thelma Terry of Texas City, TX; a special niece, Sabre Winchester of Saginaw, MI; and a niece he thought of as a sister, Agnes Johnson, also of

Saginaw, MI; and devoted friends, Mr. and Mrs. Frank and Mattie Moore. Also, cherishing his memory is a host of nieces, nephews, relatives and friends.

Funeral service will take place at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, December 21, 2013 at Evans & Browne's Funeral Home, 441 N. Jefferson Avenue. Pastor Miles D.
