Mr. Robinson passed away Monday, April 5, 2010 at his home due to heart failure. He was born in Saginaw, MI to the late Fredrick and Corine (Ivey) Robinson. He attended Saginaw Public Schools for three years until his family moved to Burt, MI, where he attended Fosters School. Mr. Robinson was a veteran of the United States Army. He attended Bay City Junior College, the American Baptist Theological Seminary and Carolina Christian College, where he received his B.A. Degree. Mr. Robinson was a long time member of the Mt.
