Mr. Walter Hugh Halliday passed away Thursday, April 23, 2015 at the age of 95 years at Magnumcare of Saginaw after a lengthy illness. He was born January 24, 1920 in Grenada, MS to Walter and Anna (Troutman) Halliday.

Walter retired from Saginaw Steering Gear-General Motors in 1982 after 30 years of service as a security guard.
