Minister William Quinn "Pug" Fuller, born April 8, 1956, in Jackson, Tennessee, departed this life on Wednesday, April 26, 2017, after a lengthy illness at the age of 61 years. He attended Madison County Public Schools in Jackson, Tennessee, and later moved to Saginaw, Michigan, where he lived with his grandparents and graduated from St Joseph's Catholic School in Saginaw, Michigan.

Quinn accepted Jesus Christ at an early age and became a member of Home Baptist Church. Throughout his entire life, he remained steadfast in Christian Doctrine and was one of the Assistant Pastors at Gethsemane House of Prayer in Detroit Michigan, where Bishop Elizabeth Gilmore presides.
