



Mr. Willie Maxwell

November 7, 1937 - January 16, 2024

Willie Draper Maxwell was born on November 7, 1937 in Lockesburg, AR to Mervin Harrison Maxwell and Lillie Mae (Scroggins) Maxwell. His family later moved to Saginaw, Michigan where he attended public school. Many of his friends and family members in Saginaw affectionately referred to him as Willie Draper or Draper.

As a young man, Willie moved to Chicago, IL before later settling in Evanston, IL. Willie was married to Vonnie (Saucier) Maxwell for 22 years. He was later married to Sue (McNeil) Maxwell.

Willie retired from the United States Postal Service in 1997 after an honorable career of 30 years of service. During his retirement he spent several years working as a shuttle bus driver for a local senior living facility where he was beloved by all of his passengers.

Later in his life, Willie relocated to Prince Georges County MD to be closer to his oldest daughter and grandson, and he remained there until the time of his transition. Willie passed away peacefully on Tuesday, January 16, 2024 in Doctors Community Hospital in Lanham, MD with his Daughter April holding his hand.

He leaves to cherish his memory, his aunt, Zora Scroggins of Chicago, IL, his

sister, Barbara Gill of Burton, MI, his son, Mervin Anthony Maxwell of North Chicago, IL; his daughters, April Maxwell Hart of Bowie, MD and Michelle M. 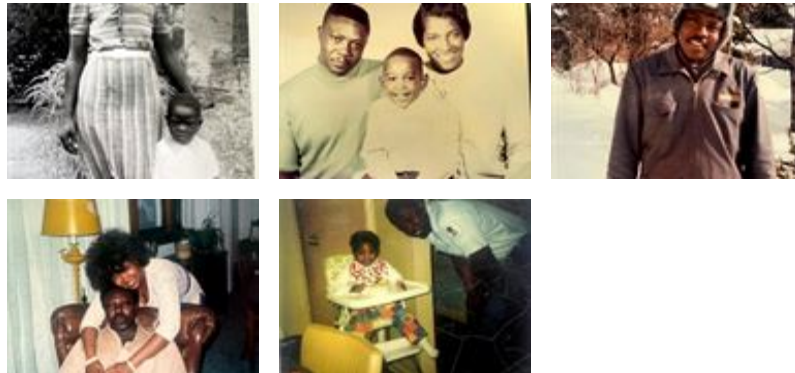

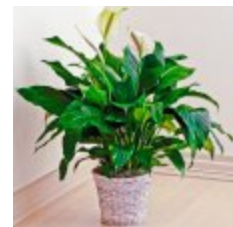
