October 31, 1917 - February 10, 2013

Our beloved mother, grandmother and great-grandmother went home to be with her heavenly Father on Sunday, February 10, 2013, at Kith Haven ECF in Flint, MI at the blessed age of 95 years. She was born October 31, 1917 in Ottawa, KS, the daughter of Frank and Cora (Bradshaw) Boston. She accepted Christ at an early age.

Winifred graduated from Kansas High School in Ottawa, KS, and relocated to Saginaw, MI shortly after graduation. She joined Zion Missionary Baptist Church in 1938, under the leadership of Rev. Schatein. Winifred was an active member of Zion MBC where she was the past secretary of the Young Matrons, the Missionary Society and B.Y.P.U. She was also past correspondence Secretary of the Missionary Society and a former member of the Usher Board.

Winifred met and married Jan D. Byrd. In 1944, they celebrated 50 years together. She retired from St. Mary's Medical Center after 21 years of service in the Dietary Dept. Winifred loved her job and was very good at her position. She carried her dietary education within her own home cooking, and was quick to let others know the proper proportion, or if you were using too much salt or sugar with your meals.

Winifred enjoyed taking care of her family, gardening and canning. She was a

precise person who always believed in doing things correctly. She had a smile that could melt anyone's heart. Winifred loved to entertain at her home and was a good hostess.
